

Bishops Gate Course Rules

1. Golfers are expected to exercise good golf etiquette as it relates to on and off-course behavior, respect for one another, respect for the facility, and proper golf attire. Aggressive or confrontational behavior is unacceptable, as is urinating in public, etc.
2. When using Bishops Gate golf carts, the golfer to golf cart ratio is to be 2:1 at all times.
 - Ex) 2 golfers = 1 cart, 3 golfers = 2 carts, 4 golfers = 2 carts
 - Residents using their personal golf carts are not required to share their cart. However, in an effort to keep as many carts available as possible, it would be greatly appreciated.
3. When off a cart path, golf carts are never to be within 10 yards of any green or beyond any markers guiding golf carts away from greens. However, golfers may apply to the Membership Committee for a handicap flag and be exempted from this rule.
4. The bringing of any Guests without the purchase of a Guest Pass is a betrayal of trust and a serious infringement.

Procedure for Disciplinary Action

- Members may approach another Member with their complaint, and then bring it to Danny Nash, who will address the violation of any of the above rules directly with the Member.
- For a major, or repeated violation, the Member will be asked to appear in front of the Membership Committee where both parties will have the opportunity to give their viewpoint.
 - The Membership Committee has the authority to immediately terminate memberships for serious violations (with some pro-rata refund of dues paid) or to decide not to renew the Membership at the annual renewal review.
